

Please note that all bookings for Rare Bird Gin School sessions are subject to the following terms and conditions:–

Cancellations:

We require a MINIMUM of 48 hours' notice for cancellations or rescheduling of bookings. We reserve the right to retain deposits or payments where this notice is not given.

Age Restrictions:

Guests must be over the age of 18.

Under 18s may enter the shop area, only if accompanied by an adult.

Under 18s are not permitted to purchase or consume alcoholic drinks, nor are they permitted to enter the production, or gin school areas whilst the gin school events are in progress.

We operate a strict Challenge 25 policy – guests who appear under the age of 25 are likely to be asked for ID.

Payment:

Guests using a gin school ticket must bring the ticket to the event, and produce it upon arrival. In the event that a guest fails to bring their ticket to the event, *and* we are unable to locate their ticket on the internal booking schedule, the right is reserved to deny entry, or require full payment in order to partake in the event.

Gin School Tickets are for the sole purpose of attending gin school events. They CANNOT be redeemed for any other purpose or used for the purchase of alcohol or other Rare Bird merchandise.

Dress Code:

Guests are asked to adhere to a casual/smart dress code, and not wear attire which may cause offence or embarrassment to other guests.

Tickets:

Tickets are non-refundable under any circumstances.

Ticket expiry dates are generally adhered to but may be extended at our discretion. For further enquiries, please contact us directly.

All deposits are non-refundable.

Seating:

The Gin School facility can host a maximum of 10 guests. **This includes both gin makers and observers.** Rare Bird cannot be held accountable for denying entry to the session where guests have not made clear at the time of booking they are attending with an Observer.
